The obligation of 2019 EQIP contracts are currently on hold as a result of new Farm Bill rules. FSA staff is currently furloughed however staff will be working limited hours to service farm loans. A quality assurance review is being scheduled for the Vineland Service Center for the upcoming year. Nick also presented the NRCS Civil Rights document to the Board. Several conservation plans

were presented for approval. Motion to approve the NRCS action items made by Henry and seconded by Ralph. Passed.

SSCC

John presented the SSCC report. The SSCC is looking for feedback on the 2019 Annual Conference location and schedule. The Districts met with NJDEP to review staff assignments regarding the 5G3 stormwater permit and to work collectively to enforce the permit. John updated the Board on the Stormwater Utility bill as it progresses through the Legislature

Agriculture Issues

Several Ag issues are working through CADB/SADC mediation. These issues involve agricultural runoff from Greenhouse/Nursery operations and the subsequent flooding of downstream landowners.
